## Composite Worktop Information

Composite stone is a mixture of quartz and resin, less porous than granite. It is extremely durable, easy to care for and will retain its colour and elegance. Because of these qualities it is ideally suited for kitchens and bathrooms.

**We recommend you arrange to view your slabs before we template as variations do occur and dissatisfaction cannot be accepted as our responsibility.**

## Care & Maintenance

You will find information on the attached sheet but as a quick guide, keep these points in mind -

- Clean on a regular basis using a cloth and soapy water or mild detergent.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaning materials e.g. scouring pads.
- Avoid using bleach or other chlorine based cleaners, acids or concentrated disinfectants. If they come into contact with the stone, clean them off quickly.
- Food that is strongly coloured, acidic or oily e.g. red wine, lemon juice and cooking oil can stain the surface. Clean any such spillages as soon as they occur.
- Avoid cutting directly onto the stone surface. Always use a chopping board. This will also stop your knives from blunting.
- Put hot pans on a pan stand.

## General Information

At time of templating and fitting we will need clear access to the room. Please ensure all removable items have been cleared from the work areas and entrance points, as no responsibility will be accepted should accidental damage occur.

Due to the nature of stone, joints will be visible and can be felt.

Slabs purchased and brought in from abroad are already polished on surface and cannot be enhanced, therefore minor blemishes or scratches may be seen after installation and no come back can be made at this point. This is why we advise strongly that slabs are always viewed before templating.

We sell up to 200 different products, and maintenance can vary dramatically for each one. We therefore advise every effort is taken by yourselves that products you have selected meet your expectations in quality and for the particular environment you wish to use it in.
