## Marble Information

Marble is a softer, slightly porous stone with various surface finishes. It is durable, easy to care for and will retain its colour and elegance. Because of these qualities it is ideally suited for bathrooms.

Marble has a natural make-up and beauty. Therefore variations in veining and colour, as well as natural markings, pits, dull patches and vents are unavoidable, but mean that your project will be unique. All materials supplied are stopped or reinforced where necessary and no claim on this account can be made.

**Because of these points we recommend all arrange to view their stone before its cut.**

## Stone Care

- Clean on a regular basis using a cloth and soapy water or mild detergent.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaning materials e.g. scouring pads.
- Avoid using bleach or other chlorine based cleaners, acids or concentrated disinfectants. If they come into contact with the stone, clean them off quickly.
- Products that are strongly coloured or oily can stain the surface. Clean any such spillages as soon as they occur.
- Over time, it is normal for the original high sheen to mellow. You can purchase from us a polishing cream to restore dull patches that could occur from normal wear and tear.

## General Information

At time of templating and fitting we will need clear access to the room. Please ensure all removable items have been cleared from the work areas and entrance points, as no responsibility will be accepted should accidental damage occur.

Please be aware that due to the nature of stone, joints will be visible and can be felt.

Slabs purchased and brought in from abroad are already polished on surface and cannot be enhanced, therefore minor blemishes or scratches may be seen after installation and no come back can be made at this point. This is why we advise strongly that slabs are always viewed before cutting is commenced.

We sell up to 200 different products and maintenance can vary dramatically for each one. We therefore advise that products you have selected meet your expectations for the particular environment you wish to use it in.
